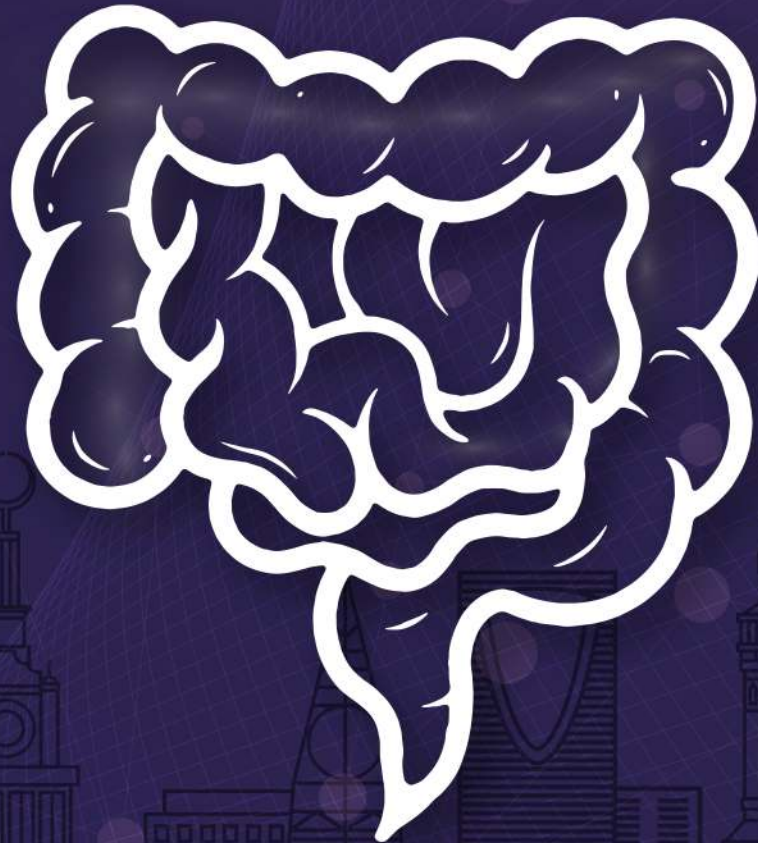

Dr. Abdulelah Almutairdi

Dr. Abdulelah Almutairdi is a gastroenterology consultant in King Faisal Specialist Hospital & Research Center (KFSHRC) in Riyadh. He is an assistant professor in Alfaisal University in Riyadh. He is currently the director of adult gastroenterology fellowship program in KFSHRC. He has advanced clinical fellowship in inflammatory Bowel disease from University of Calgary, Canada. He is a member of Saudi Gastroenterology Association.



Dr. Sara El ouali

Dr. Sara El Ouali, MD, is a staff physician in the Digestive Disease Institute at Cleveland Clinic Abu Dhabi and a Clinical Assistant Professor of Medicine at Cleveland Clinic Lerner College of Medicine, Case Western Reserve University in Cleveland, Ohio.

Prior to joining Cleveland Clinic Abu Dhabi, Dr. El Ouali worked in Montreal, Canada, where she previously earned her medical degree from McGill University and where she was awarded several scholarships for academic excellence.

Dr. El Ouali completed her Internal Medicine residency at the McGill University Health Center, where she was awarded the Ezra Lozinski prize in recognition of her outstanding compassion, understanding and sense of responsibility.

She completed her Gastroenterology & Hepatology fellowship as Chief Resident at McGill University, and then underwent additional advanced training in inflammatory bowel disease at the Cleveland Clinic in Ohio. She acquired extensive experience managing complex patients with IBD during her time in Cleveland.

Dr. El Ouali is American and Canadian-Board certified in Internal Medicine and Gastroenterology.

Dr. El Ouali has published numerous articles and book chapters and has presented at major international conferences. She is actively involved in IBD research and academic activities with Cleveland Clinic, Ohio and other international sites. She is the associate co-editor of the IBD Journal for social media and is also part of the editorial team of several gastroenterology journals.

Dr. El Ouali is passionate about gastroenterology, and has a special interest in Crohn's disease and ulcerative colitis. Other interests include the impact of COVID-19 on patients with IBD and other gastrointestinal diseases.



Prof. Miguel Regueiro

Dr. Regueiro is the Chief of the Digestive Disease Institute at Cleveland Clinic, and Professor in the Department of Medicine, Cleveland Clinic Lerner College of Medicine of Case Western Reserve University. He is responsible for the clinical operations and academic mission of the Institute; this includes the departments of general surgery, colorectal surgery, gastroenterology, hepatology, and nutrition with sites in Ohio, Florida, London, and Abu Dhabi.

Dr. Regueiro's main clinical and research interest is Inflammatory Bowel Diseases (IBD) with a focus on the natural course and medical-surgical management of Crohn's disease and ulcerative colitis. He leads research on postoperative prevention of Crohn's disease, as well as developing new models of healthcare, including the first-of-its kind specialty medical home for IBD.



Dr. Badr Albawardy

Dr. Albawardy is a consultant gastroenterologist and IBD specialist at King Faisal Specialist Hospital and Research Center in Riyadh, Saudi Arabia. He is an adjunct assistant professor at Yale School of Medicine in CT, USA and Alfaisal University in Riyadh, Saudi Arabia.

After completing medical school at the George Washington University, Dr. Albawardy completed an internal medicine residency, gastroenterology fellowship and IBD fellowship at the Mayo Clinic in Rochester, MN, USA. He then joined the faculty at Yale University as an assistant professor of medicine where he developed and lead the Yale IBD Fellowship Program. Dr. Albawardy's main interests within IBD include clinical outcomes research and medical education. He has served previously as associated editor for the Saudi Journal of Gastroenterology and is currently on multiple editorial boards of GI journals.



Prof. Ala' Sharara

Dr. Ala Sharara is Professor of Medicine at the American University of Beirut Medical Center and previous Chief of the Division of Gastroenterology at AUBMC from 2002-2017. He is also a Consulting Professor at Duke University in Durham, NC, USA. He has American Board Certification in Internal Medicine and Gastroenterology and is a fellow of the American College of Gastroenterology and of the American Gastroenterological Association, and the Royal College of Physicians (London). Dr. Sharara is a member of the AGA, ACG, WEO, ECCO, and the Lebanese Society of Gastroenterology. He has over 200 published peer-reviewed articles and 4 book chapters and serves on the editorial boards of Gastrointestinal Endoscopy, American Journal of Gastroenterology, Clinical Gastroenterology & Hepatology, and World Journal of Gastroenterology, and is an associate editor of Inflammatory Intestinal Diseases. He was guest editor of two recent special issues (one on diverticular disease, and another on challenges and controversies in IBD) in Inflammatory Intestinal Diseases and one special issue on liver disease in the Middle East for Clinical Liver Disease. Dr. Sharara is the recipient of the Golden Jubilee Clinical Research Excellence Award from the Lebanese National Council for Research in 2012. He is a member of the National Committee on CRC Screening and is the current president of the Lebanese Society of Gastroenterology and the coordinator of the national IBD interest group. Dr. Sharara spearheaded the founding of- and is a medical advisor to- I Battle Disease, the first IBD patient association in Lebanon and the Middle East, and is a member of SAID (Spread Awareness Increase Detection) patient association on CRC screening. He is the founding president of IBDacademe, a regional Middle East initiative to enhance education, harness expertise, foster academic opportunities and partnerships, and develop quality control initiatives and collaborative research in IBD, by bringing together a community of professionals, educators and academics in an effort to improve the IBD standard of care in the region.



Dr. Mahomoud Mosli

Dr. Mosli is currently an associate professor of medicine, and a consultant gastroenterologist, who is specialized in inflammatory bowel diseases (IBD), at the department of medicine, King Abdulaziz University Hospital, Jeddah, Saudi Arabia. He completed his internal medicine residency and gastroenterology fellowship training at the University of Western Ontario (UWO), London, Canada, followed by a 1-year advanced clinical IBD fellowship at UWO. He then completed a Masters degree in Epidemiology and Biostatistics from McGill University, Montreal, Canada followed by a 1-year IBD Clinical Trials Fellowship from the Robarts Research Institute. He has more than 100 publications mainly in the field of IBD and is an associate editor of the Saudi Journal Of Gastroenterology and The IBD Cochrane collaboration group.

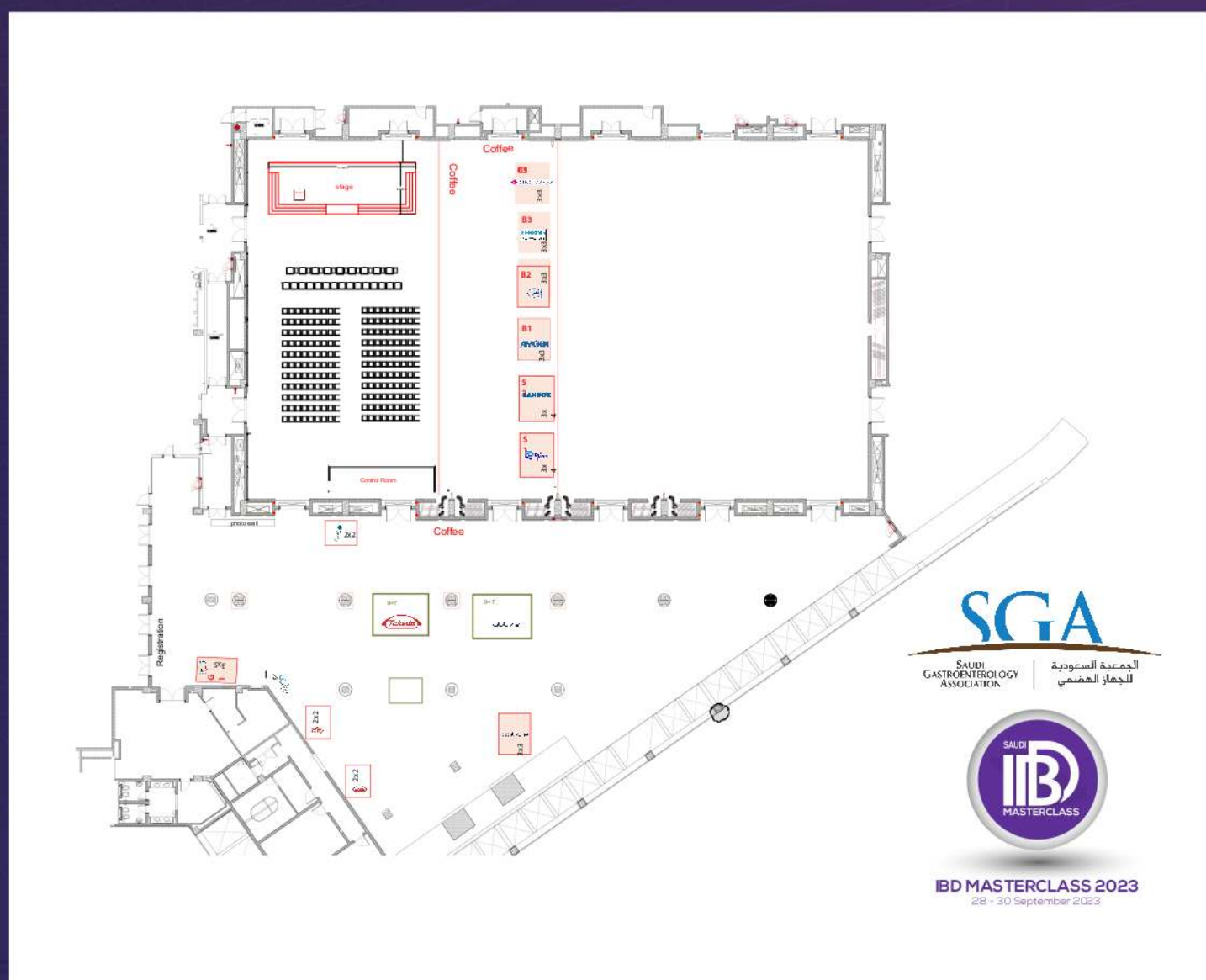
